PROJECT OF THE YEAR AWARD interior design category

The relatively short shelf life of interior design lends it the status of an experimental lab. Almost totally obliged to cope with the vagaries of weather and time, this layer of architecture in itself announces the signs of the time. Its main roles, to create atmosphere and to intensify the experience of space, are gained through technology and innovative building materials. Here, the recent advantages of digitization are put to test - advanced computerized technology through which the assimilation of virtual content into actual reality is made, and systems aimed at time- and resource-saving are coordinated.

As interior design deals mainly with predetermined situations, great significance is ascribed to the creative mind and improvisation. Hence, the criteria for assessment were: effective and economical planning, creative implementation of materials and advanced technologies, and focus on a unifying design code.
